

Outcomes

Overall Retention

78% of ABLE students increased at least one academic level or progressed in level.

GED Completion

76% of ABLE students who took the GED test, passed it.

Entered Post-secondary Education/Training

21% of ABLE students enrolled in post-secondary education or training.

Employment

44% of ABLE students who were unemployed at enrollment subsequently got a job.
