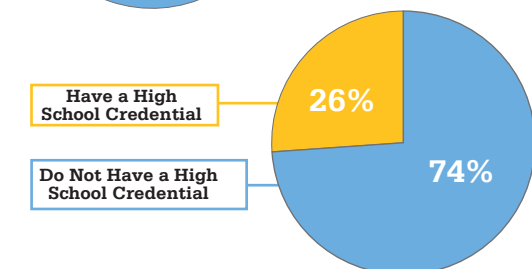
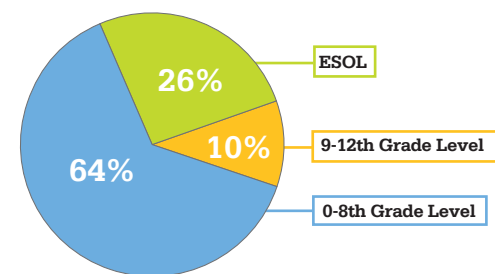

## Outcomes

### Overall Retention

**78%** of ABLE students increased at least one academic level or progressed in level.

### GED Completion

**76%** of ABLE students who took the GED test, passed it.

### Entered Post-secondary Education/Training

**21%** of ABLE students enrolled in post-secondary education or training.

### Employment

**44%** of ABLE students who were unemployed at enrollment subsequently got a job.
